Conference

Conference begins on Tuesday 18th July with Registration from 2:00 pm and tea at 3:00 pm. It concludes with lunch on Friday 21st July. Accommodation is all en-suite with single and a few twin-bedded rooms available. The Conference Pack, including the Conference Programme, a list of those attending, and other papers, will be sent out at the end of June. Our Chaplain this year is Revd Vincent Canning. The Festival of Hymns is in Christ Church Carmarthen, the parish church of the University. The commentator will be Rhidian Griffiths, President of the Welsh Hymn Society.

Conference Speakers include

It is also hoped to include lectures on Erik Routley (1917-1982) and Welsh hymn tunes.

There will be a Short Metre session, Sectionals include a Workshop by Ruthie Thomas, the Life and Hymns of Caryl Micklem and Hymns about Healing. There will also be an Outing to include the home of William Williams and hopefully a short piano recital.

Cost

The cost for residents will be £260.00 and for day-visitors for the entire conference £160.00, or charged pro-rata according to length of stay and events on each particular day (see form). Accommodation for additional nights either side of the conference is available: Bed and Breakfast £35.00 per person. Dinner (at 7.30 pm) is an additional £10.00.
